





Steps to create a mobile app with Builderfly:



Once you select all the options, Builderfly AI flow is ready to setup your mobile app by syncing your home page, welcome page, category, sub category, product image, and product detail.



The splash screen is the window that appears when an application is opened. It is a bold first impression of your brand identity. You can customize the screen to add your logo or an image along with the current version of your software.




Splash Settings



Select the image from the gallery and with the 'Cropper' you can crop any image by selecting a particular area.






Welcome Screen






- Choose from the ready-to-use login templates and click on the 'Save' button.

You can click on the toggle button to integrate your social media handles such as Facebook and twitter.




Registration Screen

Things you can do:



Suppose if we select above template then we can edit the name of first name, last name, password, confirm password, email and signup as well.




Forgot Password Screen



You can change the display name for each field on this screen viz. 'Forgot Password' and 'Email'.




Home Screen






Menu Screen


Products Screen

There are many sub-categories to the Products option, they are:






Categories








Sub Category

- Click on the 'Refresh' icon above the color palette to sync data from the online store







Cart

- Click on the 'Refresh' icon above the color palette to sync data from the online store






Checkout




Notification






My Account


Design Section

App Settings

The app settings page allow you to make all the settings regarding your mobile application such as the application name, the logo, theme mode, theme color, custom background, and much more. You can change the complete look of your app and attract more customers in style.

- Upload custom background as per your preference
- Choose a color from the color palette or sync with the web store
- Choose the color for each text, borders, and images as per the requirement
- If you wish to reset the changes made in the 'App Settings', click on the 'Reset' button
- You can also click on the 'Reset App' button at the top right corner to reset all the changes made in the app
- Save all the changes made by clicking on the 'Save' button



Notification

Build History

The Build History displays all the build generated for your mobile application. It helps you keep track of the build as well as manage them accordingly.

- Filter you search for the build based on the date of the build generation
- Search a particular build using the search bar
- Click on the page number to view the build history of the particular page
- Create a new build
- Filter the number of search results


